

2378. Coin-Op. **Antique Three compartment gumball machine, c. 1920.** Vertical free standing with a 3 compartment penny gumball/candy, red and black. No Mfg notation on machine. This is a real classic! 40"x11"x7". Fine to very fine. Est. \$400-800



2379. Coin-Op. **Columbia 25 Cent Slot Machine, 1940's.** This style of slot machine is written up on page 173 of Fey's book *Slot Machines*. Traditional fruit/ball gum/liberty bells/cherry payout card on face, nice condition. This style of machine was made between 1939 and 1950. 14"x16"x12". Very fine. Est. \$800-1400

2380. Coin-Op. **Dice Machine, c. 1955-65.** Very early electronic gaming machine which played craps. Throws and reads the dice. Operates with quarters and working condition. 48"x14"x20". This one is reportedly working, but we have not tested it ourselves. Extremely fine. Est. \$400-800

Lot 2380/81 and 2378, respectively. 2380 and 2381 are very similar.

2381. Coin-Op. **Dice Machine, c 1955-65.. Electronic gaming machine** that played craps. Same as above lot. Currently not in working condition. Includes extra parts and instruction manuals. 48"x14"x20". Fine condition. Est. \$250-500

2382. Coin-Op. **Take-Your-Pick Gaming Machine, One cent, c1930..** "Take Your Pick" gambling machine. Pays in coins. Wall mounted gaming machine that resembles a pinball machine. Very early. English made. The colorful game face, made of laminated material, has a crack running horizontally through the top part. Fine oak cabinet. Chrome finished hardware. British origin. Very nice piece. 42"x20"x6". Very fine. Est. \$600-1200

2383. Coin-Op. **Punch-A-Ball Trade Stimulator, bar (saloon) trade stimulator, ca. 1950s.** Contains all the pay out cards, five cent denomination, titled "Punch a Ball", lever punches ball along on the scale that goes from one to twenty. Glass is broken. 12"x7"x4". Fine to very fine. Est. \$100-300



2384. Coin-Op. **Counter top Lucky Strike Trade Stimulator.** Trade stimulator for pre-World War II cigarettes, solid green package shown on window, also can win other brands of cigarettes, colorful glass front art work, sit flat on a bar, roulette wheel configuration. 6"x8"x14". The top artwork is a color Xerox of the original. Very fine. Est. \$200-500

2385. Coin-Op. **Allwin De luxe Gaming Machine, 1913.** Pays in coins. The game is encased in a beautiful stained oak cabinet. Brass handles and knobs with key. 24" x 5". Aluminum innards, along with the original game name plaque visible through window. Attractive. 36"x18"x4". Extremely fine. Choice early British machine. Est. \$1500-3000

2386. Coin-Op. **Bryan's Elevensens Gaming Machine, c.1915,** English made. Coin tubes have been converted to take US coins. Very colorful game that is faced with large red, white, green, yellow and blue stripes. Very nice. Lock on door doesn't work, so the door doesn't shut. Probably fixable. Chrome finished fixtures in a stained oak cabinet. Very nice. 36"x18"x4". Choice early British gaming machine. Extremely fine. Est. \$1000-2000

2387. Coin-Op. **Buckley Criss-Cross Point Maker Trade Stimulator** with a separate electronic box that also kept score. Three reel style machine with right hand side lever. Points are collected and displayed the jackpot area. 26"x15"x12". Extremely fine. Est. \$750-1500

2388. Coin-Op. **Double Acorn Nut Dispenser, 10 cent nut dispenser gumball machine.** Two machines atop one base, free standing. Acorn embossed in glass. Red with clear glass cannisters. The item is set in a 2 1/2' stand with round base. One of the canisters is broken. 40"x15"x6". Very fine. Est. \$100-200



2389. Coin-Op. **Waist Belt Coin Dispenser.** Metal belt money changer, usually used at casinos. 5"x10"x2". Fine. Est. \$50-150



2390. Coin-Op. Mills Vest Pocket Gaming Machine. Three-reel slot machine, oak cabinet, nickel denomination, bar top size. This item was found in Darwin, CA. Without a metal case, thus the new woodcase which does not resemble the original *Vest Pocket*. See Fey, p171. 10"x10"x12". Fine condition. Est. \$100-400



2391. Coin-Op. Casino Slot Machine Banks. Set of three different, early slot machine banks. First one says "Jackpot Bank" and has a picture of state of Nevada with towns of Carson City, Las Vegas, Reno and Elko. The second has a picture of Vegas Vic between "Las Vegas.". The third is a rusty relic of similar character. The first two are made by Jack Pot Bank, Reno. 5"x4"x3". Fine. Est. \$150-300



2392. Coin-Op. Slot Machine Bank. Red and gold slot or bank machine. Four reels, right side lever. "Nevada" across the top. 11"x8"x7". c. 1960(?). Very fine. Est. \$25-50

2393. Coin-Op. Gaming Punch Boards. Unused. Larger board is "White Horse Barrel" 5 cent denomination. Smaller board is "Lucky Bucks" 5 cent. 10"x12" and the second is 9"x 6". Very Fine. Est. \$100-200

2394. Coin-Op. Japanese Niihijin Pachinko Machines, c. 1970's. Three different machines. All poor to good. 36"x22"x5". Fine. Est. \$150-300

2395. Coin-Op. Stock Exchange Gaming Machine, made by Samson Novelty Co., London, c.1900. Nice oak cabinet, with chrome fixtures. Yellow painted front, with game title in chrome and red. This game would take a penny, the reel would spin and the player would win a stock in wheat, barley and other goods, and would be paid accordingly. Was meant for entertainment only. Back is missing. Wall mounted machine. 42"x20"x6". Extremely fine. Rare early British gaming machine. See explanation in the introduction. Est. \$1500-3000

2396. Coin-Op. Parking Meter. Common modern style and shape. Probably C.1950-1970 when a quarter still got you an hour. Pole mount is not attached. Would sit nicely on a shelf or table. 24"x7"x6". Very Fine. Est. \$50-150

2397. Coin-Op. Traveling Coin Scale, c1930-40. It was used to weigh nickels and pennies. This practice is still used today in casinos. This piece was probably used by a contractor who traveled to the smaller towns in Nevada servicing slot machines. Made by Hanson. 10"x8"x10". In original leather carrying case. Art deco style. See Fey, p156. Extremely fine. Est. \$450-900



2398. Coin-Op. Pick-A-Pack Cigarette Trade Stimulator, c1935. Operated with dice and a 1 cent stimulator. Red/Orange/Black front. Locking back with key. 11"x7"x11". Choice Art Decol. Extremely fine. Est. \$350-700

2399. Coin-Op. One Cent Gum Machine, c. 1937. Counter top, vertical, rectangular dispenser. Lever allows for the gum selection from one of the vertical dispensing bins. Bronze paint has rust spots. 16"x5"x10". Very fine. Est. \$200-400

2400. Coin-Op. Imp Gum/Tobacco Trade Stimulator, c1930-40.. Coin buys a ball of gum, but you can win a pack of cigarettes if the three reels make a three of a kind. Reels consist of various brands of cigarettes. 5"x5"x4". Extremely fine. See Fey, p170 for similar machine. Est. \$200-400

2401. Coin-Op. Challenger Arcade Machine with a gun. Set up like a small pin ball machine in a table top style. Gun shoots at nine targets. Gold and red paint, with metal top at back. Hunting and battle scenes around sides. 14"x8"x22". c. 1940(?). Extremely fine. Est. \$400-800



2402. Coin-Op. Mint Dispenser. Five cent gum and mint dispenser. Mfg. By the Chicago Gum and Candy Co., Chicago. Gum is selected by individual coin slots under each brand. Dispensed by plunger. Black metal, clear glass. 14"x6"x4". c. 1938(?). Very fine. Est. \$250-500

2403. Coin-Op. U-Select-It Vending Machine, 10 cent denomination. c. 1940's. Candy. 72"x15"x15". Crème and red. Free-standing floor model. Very Fine. Est. \$400-800

2404. Coin-Op. Barn-Yard-Golf 1 cent poker machine, c. 1935, red with wood top and brass side lever. 16"x6"x10". Fine to very fine. Set up like a pinball machine. Face plate has a poker hand with yellow background. The balls fell into hands to determine poker hand. Est. \$400-800

2405. Coin-Op. Ginger Cigarette Trade Stimulator. 1 cent stimulator machine, three reel style with right hand side lever. Reels have cigarette designs. Blue paint with design of woman smoking a cigarette on the front. Has key to back. Classic art deco. See Fey, p156. 12"x8"x8". Extremely fine. Est. \$500-900

2406. Coin-Op. Penny-Pack Gum Trade Stimulator. Early, perhaps 1920-30. One cent gum dispensing machine. Three reel style machine with right hand lever. The reels have designs of cigarette packs. No back on machine The paint is gone from most of the machine. 12"x10"x8". No back. As Is. Est. \$300-600



2407. Coin-Op. Black Jack Chip Tray. Metal black jack chip holding tray. Has 8 chip slots. 14"x8"x3". Extremely fine. Est. \$50-100

2408. Coin-Op. Slot Machine Payout Plaque styled as a black brass payout table. Has bars, bells, cherries, watermelons, and plums pictured. 3"x6". Extremely fine. Est. \$25-50

2409. Coin-Op. Abbott coin changer, model AN230. Wood box shell that flips up to reveal coin changer mechanism. 10"x9"x12". Extremely fine. Est. \$150-300

2410. Coin-Op. National Cash Register, c. 1890's. Fancy brass metal with glass top and marble counter. 18"x12"x15". Extremely fine. Est. \$300-600
