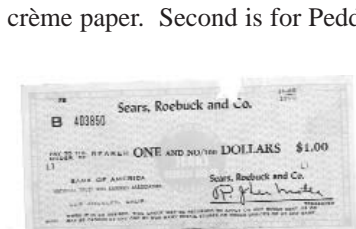

2683. Photographs. **Velvet covered photo album,** c. 1870s, with some cabinet photos in it of family, unknown. Table top custom stand. All cabinet portraits are **Denver,** circa 1885-90 Est. \$50-100

2684. Projector. **Early projector in original box.** Kodescope Model by Easman Kodak, 1924. About 8mm. Very neat piece. Est. \$50-150

2685. Projector. **Keystone Radiopticon.** Keystone Radiopticon. Very early type of projector or photo projection machine. Appears to be complete. 10"x14"x8. Est. \$100-300

2686. Projector. **Film Projector,** probably 16mm, C.1950's. Univex brand. Appears to be complete. Includes original box. Est. \$50-150

2687. Railroad. **Collection of dated RR Nails.** Probably from the Mojave Desert (Randsburg), most are from 1934. Approximately 30. Est. \$25-50

2689. Saloon. **Two Small Spittoons.** Lot of two small Spittoons. One porcelain, with blue crackle pattern, the other similar to granite ware, but not. Tin with light gray speckles on white. The porcelain has a large, jagged chip out of the lip, probably 3" long. Both are original saloon spittoons. 6"x9" radius. Est. \$100-200



2690. Saloon. **Brass Spittoons.** Lot of two large spittoons. One is modern, made to look old, and the other is an original saloon spittoon. Both are metal. The original has several stains throughout. The modern one has little wear, and has a shiny brass surface. Both are nice pieces. c. 1865/1960. 9"x12". Est. \$100-200

2691. Saloon. **Saloon Chairs.** Lot of three different saloon chairs. All are made of oak. Varying condition; one has been steadfastly repaired by a miner, found in an old miner's cabin about 1955. 36"x30"x30". Est. \$150-300

2694. Scales. **Chinese Scale.** Chinese Scale with pan and original balance beam, with marks that correspond to specific weights. Comes with a Chinese banjo scale box. Wood. Circa 1880. Came from Virginia City. Est. \$100-300
