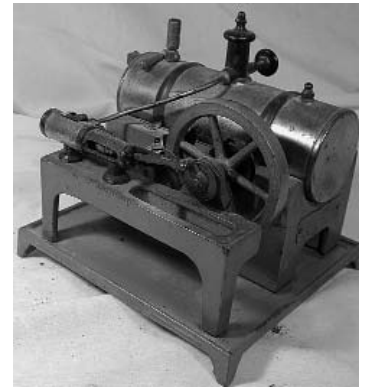


2776. Toys. **Toy Steam Engine.** Cast Iron, with brass. Red paint. Est. \$50-150
