2347. Grant. Fairplay. **Fairplay Mining & Level Co.** Incorporated in Wisconsin. Issued to Henry Schiller for 3 shares, cert #(?), in 1868. Signed by B. Kilbourne president and J. S. Sericod secretary. Crude, early vignette of spread winged eagle. Blue outer, red inner border with red and blue print under-print. Uncancelled. Printer - Herald Print. 8 x 11. Several small ink spots polka-dot entire front of certificate with minor bleed through to reverse. 25 cent revenue stamp at lower left. Two 0.5 inch pieces missing for the left and right fold at bottom edge. Dated *Fairplay, Wis.* We could not find any information regarding this company within our library. Very fine. Est. \$400-600



2348. Grant. Platteville. **Dall Lead & Zinc Co.** Incorporated in Wisconsin. Issued to Lewis Stamard for 50 shares, cert #612, in 1905. Signed by T. S. (?) president and E. Doschi secretary. Vignette at upper left of miners working underground with several small vignettes at the corners and edges of miners. Black border with green seal and green safety print. Uncancelled. Printer - Goes. 8 x 11. *Platteville, Wisconsin* printed under company name. Grant County is known to have several lead and zinc deposits. We could find no reference to this company within our library. Extremely fine. Est. \$50-100

2349. Iowa. Dodgeville. **P. H. C. Mining Co.** Incorporated in Wisconsin. Unissued. Unsigned. **Cert #1.** Vignette at upper left of spread winged eagle atop domed building. Black border with gold seal and safety print. Printer - Goes. 8 x 11. No folds. Piece ripped at upper right corner. *Dodgeville, Wisconsin* print on certificate. This and the next two lots are probably related companies. The certificates are almost identical and they both are from Dodgeville, which is located just a few miles from Platteville. Iowa County and Dodgeville are known to have had lead and zinc deposits. Very fine to extremely fine. Est. \$25-75

Very attractive letterhead with a vignette at the upper left of a sailing schooner, smaller sailing boats, a steamer and a rowboat. The letterhead states that the company designs and builds steam & sail yachts, launches, motor boats, turbine boats, row boats and canoes using steel, wood and composite materials.
