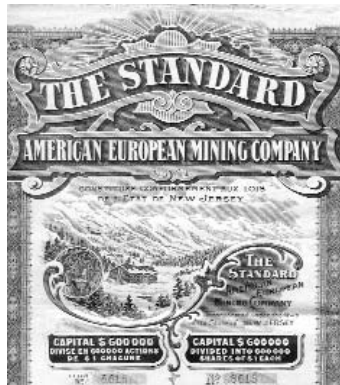

**1044.** Bolivia. Larecaja. Tipuani. **Bolivia Gold Mining Co of Colorado, c.1901.** Incorporated in Colorado, promoted from Denver. A placer mining operation located on the Tipuani River that was claimed to run \$5 to \$25 gold per yard. The dredge on site had a 300 yard daily capacity. There is a the standard expert examination and report and many testimonials. The last page has 2 maps, one showing the location of the company's property and a general view of Peru and
