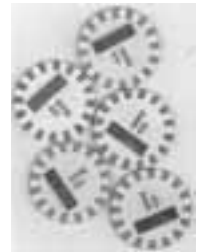

After almost 20 years of vacancy, plans were in motion to restore the building, and convert the 12-story landmark into a time-share. But by 2000, after much controversy over its architectural soundness, and debates over its use, plans to demolish the building were made by city officials. Sadly, all that remains is an empty lot, occasionally occupied by small events. These chips are among the many relics collected from the hotel. Three different styles: 4 maroon with 4 green inserts; 2 brown with three orange inserts; 2 blue with three red inserts; and one maroon, plain. All 37mm, Fine-Vf/Xf. Est. \$50-100

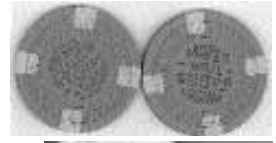
