Most of the shots were taken in the 1960-70's, one of the recent boom times for Tonopah. Around 1970, Anaconda began developing a mine 30 miles north-east of Tonopah to produce molybdenum. As part of this mine operation, Anaconda built a new neighborhood near the present day Nye County Courthouse. The price of molybdenum dropped, the mine closed. During the 1980's, the town was again booming due to the extremely high price of gold, over \$800. A minor boom hit Tonopah in the mid 1990's when Equatorial began developing a copper open pit on the same property as Anaconda tried for moly. Unfortunately, the venture failed after a short 5 years sending Tonopah into its toughest depression yet. Several of the hotels and businesses shown on these cards are no longer in business. Even the famous Jim Butler Days is a mere shell of what it was once. One of the postcards is oversize measuring 6 x 9". All Xf. Est. \$30-60
