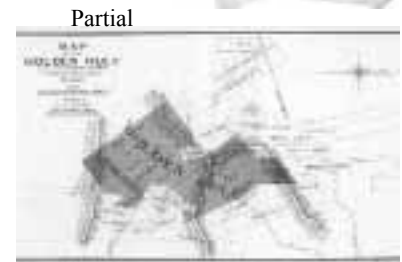

T. on the base (Whiteall-Tatum) Stowell was different in his drug store business. He was a mining man, and as such ran an assay business with the drug store, which he continued when he moved to Spokane. I know of no other druggist who ran a similar business in the west. His store was open from 1870-1882. very mint, clean bottle with only the tiniest of pin dings on the lip edge, too small to measure. Provenance: Dunn collection. Est. \$50-100

Incorporated in Nevada, 1901. Issued to Robert Smith, for 100 shares in 1901. **Signed by S. H. Wheeler** secretary and F. M. Lees president. Vignette of several oil derricks. Black border with gilt seal and bronze safety seal. Uncancelled. Printer - Goes. 8 x 10". Two adhesive revenue stamps attached along left edge. **Sam H. Wheeler** was a banker in Reno and on the Board of the Nixon National Bank, and a friend and partner of George Wingfield. We are not sure where this company had its operations or properties. Very minor wear to fold creases. Xf. Rare. Est. \$25-50

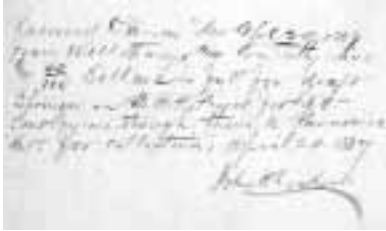

731. Humboldt. National. **Thos. McGriff/National,/Nev.//GF/12.5/IT/At the Bar.** Rd, alum, 21mm. Minor rim dings. Reverse has minor pitting. Vf. National was a mining camp discovered by J. L. Workman in 1907. Workman named several geographic features after automobile parts. National got its name from the car he drove. Locally there is a Radiator Hill. In 1909, the Stall brothers unearthed the National vein that was nearly pure electrum with a value of \$30,000 per ton. The post office ran from 1908-1919 (Nevada Place Names, p.175-76). The company owned the Prince and Davidson mines containing iron-manganese ore assaying at 3% lead, 34% iron, 13% manganese and 3 oz silver per ton. Between 1915-1920, the property produced 1.8 million ounces of silver and 43.5 million pounds of lead. (Mines Handbook, 1925, p.1146). Both XF. Est. \$50-100

Bovard Consolidated was formed shortly after mineral discoveries were made in the area, in 1908. Vignette at upper left of miner using hydraulic drill.
