The Ophir Mill was in Washoe Valley, and the small stone ruins there today at the north end are the only remnants of this once large processing site. 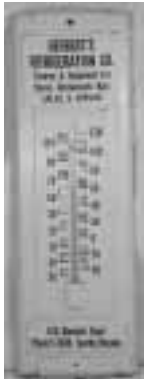

It has no seam above the neck and is lightly frosty with no visible chips. It probably dates to 1916, the first year of the store's existence, and is a rare bottle. The second is the newer (and common) variant with a seam from an automatic bottle machine manufacture running up the neck and over the top, usually indicative of post-1915 bottles. It is 6 1/8" tall, with no chips and light frost. Wilson was one of the leading druggists in Reno with a store that lasted into the second half of the twentieth century. Est. \$40-80
